Vehicle must run with headlights and taillights on at all times

Off Premises insurance will be carried at all time on the vehicle when operated on roadway

The Neighborhood Vehicle Act can and will be terminated at any time deemed necessary by the Village Board of Evansville at no expense to the Village.

Only Licensed drivers over the age of 18 may operate the vehicle on Village Roadways

Permit must be displayed on rear of vehicle

Permit is non-transferable

Citations issued will be on Village Ordinance; failure to pay fine will result in Neighborhood Vehicle Permit being revoked and citation reissued on State Statute; citation will be forwarded onto the State Attorney's office to be pursued

A permit can and will be terminated at any time due to any action considered reckless or a misuse of this act by the Village of Evansville Police Department

I fully understand that use of UTV/Golf Cart (Neighborhood Vehicle) is prohibited on Liberty Street, Broad Street, and any village sidewalk. A UTV (Neighborhood Vehicle) may cross Liberty Street and Broad only at a 90 degree angle in a safe manner.
IF YOU ARE FOUND DRIVING ON SAID STREETS OR SIDEWALKS IT WILL RESULT IN AN IMMEDIATE TERMINATION OF YOUR PERMIT!

I will observe all Vehicle operation laws set forth by the Illinois Vehicle Code and Village Ordinance.
