A UTV (Neighborhood Vehicle) may cross Liberty Street and Broad only at a 90 degree angle in a safe manner. IF YOU ARE FOUND DRIVING ON SAID STREETS OR SIDEWALKS IT WILL
RESULT IN AN IMMEDIATE TERMIATION OF YOUR PERMIT!
